How to fix a Nissan Terrano wing mirror.

Does this look familiar, you left your truck outside and some numpty decided to kick off your mirror or you have been off roading and it's been in an argument with a tree and lost, hum £25 to £40 on EBay, I think not.



The tools you're going to need for this job are:- 2.5mm drill bit, one drill and a couple of self tapping screws and the correct screwdriver head.

First remove the cover from the rear of the mirror so you can get to the inside. Don't force it to hard, it will come off.

Next line the mirror back up to where it should be and drill 2 small holes in to the base part.

Drill through enough to mark the inner part of the mirror as well and then remove it and drill through the centre part. You can drill right through, but i found the drill bits sometimes snap if you move the mirror by accident.



Then put them back together and line them up

Next screw in the 2 self tapping screws, as you can see one of the heads snapped off, but its not going to matter, this is to hold the mirror into the holder and it will still do that.



Next, put the rear cover back on and enjoy that fact you just saved some cash.



I have done this fix 3 times now and the result has been successful every time.
